A Pastor's Ponderings

Exile - Homecoming - Sending

These themes are present throughout scripture. It starts in Genesis when God's people are exiled into slavery in Egypt, and after the exodus and wandering, they return home, and are blessed to be a blessing to others.

These themes continue through the prophets when God's people are sent off (some to Assyria) to Babylon, then return home and become a light to the nations.

These themes reappear in the New Testament in the life of Jesus, and is present in Paul's theology through his letters to churches in the First Century.

These themes continue to be present with us today (maybe with COVID, national division, broken relationships, etc.). This month, during worship, we will be exploring these themes as part of a series called, "A Future with Hope." We will explore the themes as they appear in scripture and God's people responded and we will consider our own responses to exile, homecoming, and sending.

Jeremiah 29:11 says: "I know the plans I have in mind for you, declares the LORD; they are plans for peace, not disaster, to give you a future filled with hope."

May you experience hope as we explore these themes together.

Celebrated by Christian churches around the globe, World Communion Sunday promotes Christian unity and ecumenical cooperation between denominations.



Fellowship, Outreach, and Membership always prepared for a welcoming "reception" before and after worship service.


Stewardship continues to "carry" out the financial health of the church.
